




ANTWERP

Did you know that Antwerp has always been a city of sport? It hosted the Olympics in 1920, the cycling World Cup in 2021, the 3x3 basketball World Cup in 2022 and the gymnastics World Cup in 2013 and 2023. The many annual sports events attract around 100,000 participants and 600,000 spectators to the city. And this in a blend of elite sports events, mass participation events, and sports events for specific target groups. Annual highlights include the European Open ATP tennis tournament, the Antwerp 10 Miles (the biggest running event in the country) and the Antwerp Marathon. Antwerp is also home to many top sports clubs, such as football club and current cup holder and champion Royal Antwerp FC, and basketball club Antwerp Giants.

Antwerp is also the largest city in Flanders and, as a flamboyant metropolis, it has a great deal to offer. It is not only a Valhalla for fashionistas, with endless shopping streets and an actual museum dedicated to Belgian fashion, it is also the ultimate destination for lovers of good food. The city has no fewer than 22 Michelin stars spread across 18 restaurants.

Antwerp is characterised by its innovative spirit and creativity. This is also evident at the architectural level: here, you stroll from baroque churches and Late Classical masterpieces to contemporary and futuristic landmarks such as the Port House or the MAS | Museum aan de Stroom. The other museums in the city are absolute treasures too, one being the Plantin-Moretus Museum: the first museum in the world to be included on the UNESCO World Heritage List.


Art lovers can enjoy top museums such as the Royal Museum of Fine Arts Antwerp, the many art galleries, as well as the five monumental churches. Take, for example, the majestic Cathedral of Our Lady, the largest Gothic building in the Low Countries, where you can find several masterpieces by baroque grandmaster Peter Paul Rubens. You can admire the cathedral from the Linkeroever. In fact, from the other side of the Scheldt you have the best view of the city's skyline and its gigantic port, the second largest in Europe.

Finally, Antwerp has been recognised for 500 years as the diamond capital of the world. Every diamond in the world passes through Antwerp at least once! In diamond museum DIVA, visitors can view a magnificent collection and learn more about the link between Antwerp and diamonds. So this city literally and figuratively sparkles, and its inhabitants proudly describe it as "a metropolis with the atmosphere of a village".





OUDENAARDE

Oudenaarde, the heart of the Flemish Ardennes and traditionally the finish line of Flanders' Finest for several years now. In the 'Centre Tour of Flanders' museum in Oudenaarde a captivating exhibition is dedicated to the high day of the year and to the other spring classics. If you want to enjoy a local beer from Oudenaarde it is best to opt for brown beers such as Cnudde, Ename, Felix or Roman. Unlike others, these beers are still brewed on Oudenaarde soil. Fancy indulging in a little culture? Besides the race, the town hall is the pride of the city, but the Kerselare pilgrimage site and the oldest carillon bells in St Walburga's Church are also worth a visit.

"Once you've won Flanders' Finest, you remain the winner of the Tour of Flanders forever. That's a mythical feeling."


Where in Oudenaarde do you stop for a coffee during your bike ride?



BRIEK
SCHOTTE

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"FOR MY FATHER, THE DAY OF THE TOUR OF FLANDERS FELT LIKE A DATE WITH HIS LOVED ONE,"

Twenty years ago, Briek Schotte, two-time winner of the Tour of Flanders and the Flandrien of all Flandriens, died on the day of Flanders' Finest. Iron Briek holds the record for the most participations in De Ronde to date. We asked his son Johan what the Tour of Flanders meant to his father and vice versa.

How do you hope that cycling fans remember your father, Briek Schotte?

Johan Schotte: "As they always knew him, a quiet strength with a lovely character. Many people see my father as a source of inspiration. They have drawn countless years of relaxation and pleasure from what he did as a cyclist and as a human being. For his funeral, I wrote a poem wording this as

follows: 'He was a man among men and a champion among champions'. When people ask me how I remember my father, I often reply that he added the 'extra' to the 'ordinary' in life. He was an incredibly motivated man and that showed in everything he did. He would probably have been the best at anything he decided to pursue. All because of his willpower and perseverance."

How did those character traits show up in cyclist Briek Schotte?


"In the race as well, his determination was immense. Away from the races he was everybody's friend, but in the race, he rode solely to win. 'After the race, there is time enough to be friends,' he used to say. My father went to every race with the intention of beating who was second. He drew strength from that way of thinking. Iron Briek was his nickname because he never folded. He never lined up at the start just to get his cycling shorts dirty. Winning was what counted."

Briek Schotte won Tour of Flanders in 1942 and 1948. What did those victories mean for his career?

"My father loved De Ronde with all his heart. It was his dream race. For him, it was like a national holiday. Whether as a cyclist, later as a sports director or after his retirement as a fan, the day of the Tour of Flanders felt to him like a date with his loved one. There was always a healthy tension. It was not only his two victories that show that Briek Schotte and De Ronde formed a successful marriage. He rode twenty times in Flanders' Finest, a record that still stands to this day. Furthermore, he was once both the youngest and oldest rider at the start and he ended up on the podium no fewer than eight times. In fact, my father could have won Tour of Flanders even more often. Someone once convinced him that cyclists would be better off drinking a water bottle filled with champagne in the last 10 kilometres of a race because champagne contains a lot of sugars. A few kilometres after drinking such a water bottle, my father missed a turn and lost the Tour of Flanders."



How did he experience Flanders' Finest when he retired?


“De Ronde was still the highlight of the year, but the first edition when he was no longer a sports director was a tough one. There was a rule that said that after a certain age you could no longer hold a position within cycling. And so my father was forced to stop as sports director. That upset him deeply. He had devoted his entire life to cycling and suddenly he could no longer do so. It was one of the most difficult days of his life.”

Your father died on 4 April 2004, the day on which the 88th Tour of Flanders was held that year. Did the circle seem complete?

“That day was full of symbolism. My father had been in hospital for months when I suddenly got a call from one of the nurses. His condition was worsening and so we made the decision to have the anointing of the sick administered as soon as possible. To our great surprise, he lived for another thirty days. It was as if he fought until the day of De Ronde. The 2004 edition marked the return of the Tour of Flanders to the coast after a long absence. The race passed by the cemetery in Bredene where my mother was buried. She had died nine months previously. Just after the passage in Bredene, I received a phone call that my father had gone. It was as if he was waiting for his dream race to collect his beloved spouse”

Oude Kwaremont

With three passages for the Men Elite and one for the Women Elite in the deep finale, the Oude Kwaremont is one of the decisive points in the Tour of Flanders.

Sep's Insights

Sep Vanmarcke ended up on the podium of Flanders' Finest twice. We took Sep to the Oude Kwaremont and asked him why the climb is so crucial in the race, what his best and toughest memories of the climb are, and how you as an amateur cyclist can conquer the Oude Kwaremont. Watch the video above! !

Sep on the Oude Kwaremont

“The men climb the Oude Kwaremont three times. The final ascent is also the penultimate climb in the Tour of Flanders, which automatically makes it a crucial point in the race. The same goes for the women’s race. The Oude Kwaremont demands a lot of energy because it’s a long climb. The first part is the steepest, followed by a long false flat section. The chance of splits in the peloton is high, so it’s better to be at the front.”


Tips for amateur cyclists

“The highest gradients are at the beginning of the climb. That’s where you have to give everything. Then you get a false flat section where you can catch your breath. At the end, there’s another steep section, but that shouldn’t pose a big problem.”
