
# START LENNIK

“WTC de Windklievers. That is the cycling club that my father was a member of. As a 16-year-old, I would cycle with the club on Sundays, together with my dad.”


### **The nicest place in and around Lennik?**

### **Nicest training spot in the Pajottenland?**

“Congoberg or Donkstraat. That is an uphill cobblestone strip. As a teenager, I went there to do my blocks. I would ride up at full throttle and then loop round to come back to that cobblestone road again. I did that about 10 times before heading for home.”

# DISCOVER FLEMISH BRABANT FOR CYCLING HEROES

We know how to race. From heroic climbs and breath-taking descents. From cobbles that make you shiver and straight concrete roads to go full gas. You can ask Eddy Merckx where he got the taste of it. Or ask Sven Nys, who's sharing the cyclo-cross course on his Balenberg with everyone. But this is also the home of the younger generation of cyclists. Remco Evenepoel prefers racing over the roads of the Pajottenland. Jasper Stuyven has basically tested all of these roads during his long trainings rides from his home city Leuven. It's no coincidence that the biggest riders in Flemish-Brabant gathered to decide on the very best rider during the 100th birthday of the UCI Road World Championships.

Not only can you speed on these beautiful cycling roads, the off-road adventure is also calling when you leave the flat roads. The nicest gravel routes show you places your car will never get you. Take your mountain bike or cyclo-cross bike and challenge yourself on the exhausting single tracks through the woods and fields. That much variation and so many disciplines can only be found in our province. It's up to you to discover it all. So stay a little longer, because one day sure is not enough!

# EDWIG VAN HOYDONCK & DE BRABANTSE PIJL, A SUCCESSFUL MARRIAGE

Edwig van Hooydonck is to this day the proud record holder for De Brabantse Pijl for the men. ‘Eddy Bosberg’ lined up at the start of the classic, which marks the transition of the Flemish events to the Ardennes, no fewer than ten times. At the end of four of those ten editions, he was able to make the gesture of victory.

To say that De Brabantse Pijl is a race that Edwig van Hooydonck was cut out for would be stating the obvious. The Belgian can still call himself the only record holder of this race in the heart of the Drui-venstreek. Van Hooydonck lined up at the start of De Brabantse

Pijl every season between 1987 and 1996 and was able to secure victory on four occasions. Remarkably: Van Hooydonck never finished lower than seventh place in those ten editions. A reconstruction of his four successes.

## **Solo on his debut**

A debut that was certainly impressive. Edwig started De Brabantse Pijl for the first time in 1987 and immediately made his mark. At barely 20 years of age, he rode solo across the finish - then on the Alsemberg. Van Hooydonck broke away from an elite group and eventually finished more than a minute ahead of his first pursuer, Dutchman Peter Harings.

Four years later, it was victory once again for Van Hooydonck. No solo in 1991, but a power sprint. Two rounds from the end, Dutchman Ad Wijnands and Dirk De Wolf attacked. The duo were joined a little later by Ludo De Keulenaer, Van Hooydonck's teammate at Buckler - Colnago - Decca. On the final round, Edwig made the jump to the front. Dirk De Wolf started the sprint on the Alsemberg from a distance, but was overtaken at the finish by Van Hooydonck, who would win his second Tour of Flanders a week later.

## **Level with and passing Johan Capiot**

Johan Capiot had crowned himself 'Mister De Brabantse Pijl' with his three victories in 1988, 1989 and 1992, but that would be changed by Edwig Van Hooydonck. An elite group of about ten riders rode together into the final round. Andrei Tchmil began a solo effort 28 km from the finish, but the

GB-MG-Maglificio rider was reeled back in. With 15 km to go, Van Hooydonck thought his moment had come. He attacked and was joined by Tchmil, Franco Ballerini and Steven Rooks. Ten kilometres further on, Edwig went again. Only Ballerini managed to hang on, but the Italian had to give way to Van Hooydonck, who claimed his third win in De Brabantse Pijl.

Edwig completed his quartet of victories in 1995, his penultimate season as a professional rider. Van Hooydonck opened the throttle early, 70 km from the finish. Behind him, they were watching each other, but as Edwig entered the final round he was joined by Alexander Gontchenkov and Dmitri Konychev. In the three-man sprint on the Alsemberg, Van Hooydonck was unstoppable and his victory made him the record holder for De Brabantse Pijl with four successes.

In the meanwhile, the finale of De Brabantse Pijl has changed and since 2010 the finish has been in Overijse. Only Gilbert has managed to win there more than once. And so, 29 years later, Edwig Van Hooydonck's name still stands alone at the top of the honours board, since nobody in the active peloton has yet managed to triumph more than once in the last race of the Flemish spring.

# SEP'S INSIGHTS



## Moskesstraat

### Sep's Insights

Sep Vanmarcke himself rode De Brabantse Pijl twice. We went with Sep to the Moskesstraat and asked him why the climb is so crucial in the race, what his best memories of the climb are and how you as a cycling tourist can conquer the Moskesstraat.

### Sep about the Moskesstraat

“Moskesstraat is crucial because of its cobblestones and narrow passage, which means that as a rider you have to be in a good position before the start of the climb. Your body is then full of adrenaline because you have already battled for 10 km to be at the front here. If your legs still feel good after this, you can attack on the steepest part around the corner.”

## Tips voor de wielertoerist

“When you approach Moskesstraat with some energy left in the tank, you need to begin smoothly and maintain a good speed. Don’t go too hard either, because halfway up there is a steep bend and from there you have to go full throttle to reach the top.”






