
TERNEUZEN - ZEELAND


What is your best memory of the Scheldeprijs?


ZEELAND

Zeeland is a green delta and former island kingdom located between Flanders and Holland. It is culturally diverse, located at the point where the land meets the water, intersected by the two 'Scheldts' (Eastern and Western Scheldt). Zeeland has lived and fought with and against the water for many centuries. For example, Zeeland has been plagued by several storm surges, resulting in its constantly changing shape. Villages have been engulfed, even an entire city (Reimerwaal) once perished, but after the great storm surge of 1953, Zeeland is now 'dry'. The islands have been connected and protected by the Delta Works with the Oosterscheldekering (Eastern Scheldt storm surge barrier) as its most famous icon. The battle against the water continues. Examples include 'building with nature' involving new coastal defences such as Waterdunen (Zeeuws-Vlaanderen). Zeeland is home to proud but modest inhabitants who are passionate about their Zeeland and are only too happy to 'share' it with visitors who come here to enjoy the beautiful beaches, culinary qualities and rich history.

Where in Schoten do you prefer to stop for a coffee break during your bike ride?


“I prefer to stop at my father’s bike shop or at Bikefit, my own business. They are two separate businesses, but they are located in the same building. They serve delicious coffee!”


“ I WANT TO WIN AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE AND I WANT TO KEEP ON DOING SO FOR AS LONG AS POSSIBLE ”

On Wednesday 3 April, we will find out who will inherit Lorena Wiebes' crown as the winner of the Scheldeprijs. As the undisputed victor of the three previous editions, the Team SD Worx-Protime rider is now aiming for a fourth win in a row as well. We asked her what her success formula is.

The name Lorena Wiebes (24) is synonymous with success in the Scheldeprijs. Since 2021, the Dutch rider has been the absolute sprint queen of the Scheldeprijs. With three consecutive wins, she is giving her all for four in a row this year. “I want to win as much as possible. It's obviously amazing to win them one after another and I want to keep on doing so for as long as possible.

Turning point in career

She cherishes the fondest memories of her very first win in 2021 and stresses the importance of the race. “My first win was very important. It gave me a lot of self-confidence after a difficult start to the season, and after that the rest of the year went much better too. Also, the race is important for confidence as a sprinter,” she says. “Winning this race really marks you out as one of the best sprinters.”

Success formula

Lorena sees a combination of team spirit and timing as her secret weapon in the Scheldeprijs. “One thing you do need to have for the Scheldeprijs is a strong sprint,” explains Lorena. “It is known as the world championship for sprinters. But as well as that, it is crucial to have a good team around you, especially for a good lead-out.” For Lorena, her ideal sprint is not only about strength, but also about timing. “I perform best after a tough race, when I still have a good reserve left for the final,” she says. “And timing is everything. It’s perfect when the team drops me off at 150 metres from the finish after a great lead-out.”

Evolution in sprint duels

In the women’s peloton, Lorena sees an interesting development in sprint duels. “It’s a bit trickier because we don’t have as many flat races as the men,” she explains, “but that doesn’t mean we don’t have enough sprinters.” Every year she sees new talents emerge, while even more teams are investing in a strong lead-out, similar to men’s cycling. Lorena also notes: “During the race you just feel that women’s cycling is really starting to come alive, there are always a lot of people lining the circuit and that’s fantastic.” And her victory gesture? “I’m still thinking about it, but I still have time,” she concludes with a laugh.




Zeeland

With the start of the men's race in Terneuzen and a passage through Zeeland, the wind has played an important role several times in recent years.

Sep's insights

Sep Vanmarcke has started the Scheldeprijs five times during his career. And when it comes to the Scheldeprijs, people often think of crosswinds and echelons. We asked Sep what makes the passage through Zeeland so challenging, how he experienced Scheldeprijs as a rider, and how you as a cycling amateur can conquer the wind.



Sep about Zeeland

“There is often a lot of wind at the start in Terneuzen and during the passage through Zeeland. Riders can’t really protect themselves against it, so they use each other as a windbreak in the hope of saving as much energy as possible. This leads to echelons and thus also chaos in the peloton. After an edition with a lot of wind, every rider crosses the finish line exhausted. You’re in a constant battle against the wind.”

Tips for amateur cyclists

“Find yourself a strong cycling buddy and position yourself in his or her slipstream. When the wind comes from a certain direction, choose the opposite side of their wheel. That way, you’ll be well protected.”

Apply Sep’s tips yourself? Conquer the wind during the Scheldeprijs Cyclo on Saturday, April 6, and unleash your sprinter’s legs. Starting in Schoten, you’ll embark on a journey of 80, 125, or 160 kilometers. Discover the beautiful roads along the Eastern and Western Scheldt and conclude with the classic finale of the race.






